

2022 Water System Rates Increase

Along with your December water bill and invitation to the Winslow Christmas Parade you received a copy of the resolution with the new water rates for 2022.

This article will hopefully provide some explanation for the increases.

The city is required by State Law to keep the water department solvent to avoid the state taking over. A lot of small water departments had problems and the state closely monitors to make sure we can supply clean water and continue to pay our bills.

Our system is aged, and the water meters must be replaced. The funds gathered from the new monthly meter service charge will be set aside in a special interestbearing account each month. The funds will be used to purchase new replacement meters in the future.

It costs more to service and provide maintenance to customers outside the city limits.


